

Environmental Policy

The Roan Building Systems Board recognises the importance of establishing a documented environmental management system to demonstrate sound environmental performance, by controlling the impacts of waste from their activities, products and services on the environment.

To help ensure environmental controls can be delivered, Roan Building Systems are adopting an Environmental Management System (EMS), providing us with the capability to maintain and continually improve our pollution programmes.

The Roan Building Systems EMS control documents have been produced to define requirements for a management systems approach to environmental management, in accordance with the requirements of the International Standard ISO 14001-2004.

Demonstration of successful implementation of this management system will assure all interested parties to the business that an appropriate environmental management system is in place.


These specific requirements for setting up and managing an effective environmental management system emphasise Roan Building Systems commitment to:

- Minimise waste;
- Promote recycling;
- Reduce energy consumption;
- Reduce harmful emissions; and
- Where possible, to work with suppliers and customers/clients on practical environmental programmes.
- The organisation ensures that all its activities (within the defined scope) are carried out in conformance with the relevant environmental legislation and other requirements (environmental aspects) to which the organisation subscribes.

The environmental management system is a commitment to continually improve on environmental performance and the minimisation/prevention of pollution. This is achieved by setting environmental improvement objectives and targets which are regularly monitored and reviewed.

The objectives and targets are publicised throughout the company and all staff are committed to their achievement.

This Policy and the obligations and responsibilities required by the environmental management system have been communicated to all employees and other persons working on behalf of the organisation.
